<b>F#</b>	<b>F# minor</b>	<i>C# / F# / A</i>
<b>A</b>	<b>A major</b>	<i>C# / E / A</i>
<b>D</b>	<b>D major</b>	<i>D / F# / A</i>
<b>C#</b>	<b>C# major</b>	<i>C# / F / G#</i>

*Here's how to play those chords:*

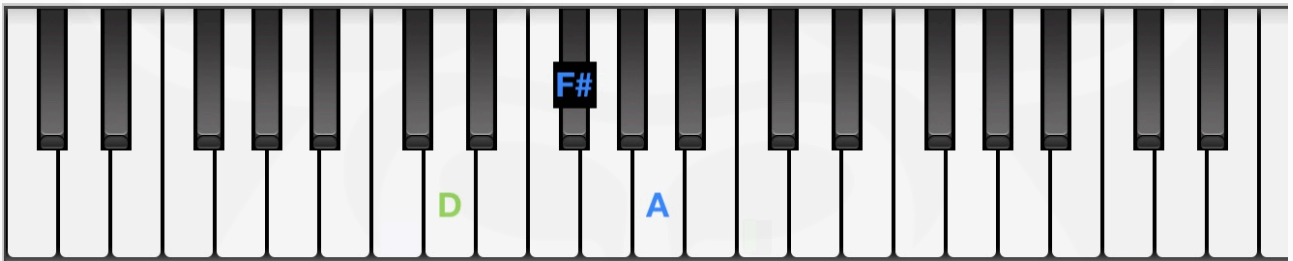
- F# minor

## RHYTHMIC PATTERN

In order to play this song, you can use the following pattern :

- **First method:** Bass / chord x time (x2)
- **Second method :** Bass / chord 5 times / Bass + chord on the 6th (x2)

## CHORDS ORDER FOR THE INTRODUCTION (First method)

BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F# (x2)	F# minor (x12)	C# / F# / A

## CHORDS ORDER FOR THE ENTIRE SONG (First method)

CHORDS / TEDDY SWIMS - LOSE CONTROL		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F# (x2)	F# minor (x12)	C# / F# / A
A (x2)	A major (x12)	C# / E / A
D (x2)	D major (x12)	D / F# / A
C# (x2)	C# major (x12)	C# / F / G#

D (x4)	D major (x12)	D / F# / A
C# (x4)	C# major (x12)	C# / F / G#
