- D minor
- E minor
- G major
- F major
- A minor

BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION	
С	C major	C - E - G	
D	D minor	D - F - A	
E	E minor	E - G - B	
G	G major	D - G - B	
F	F major	C - F - A	
А	A minor	E - A - C	



Here's how to play those chords :


- C major



- D minor





- E minor

RHYTHMIC PATTERN

In order to play this song, you can use the following pattern :

- Bass + chord / Chord

CHORDS ORDER FOR THE INTRODUCTION

THE WEEKND - SAVE YOUR TEARS			
BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION	
C (x8)	C major (x16)	C/E/G	

You will need to play this table **once** for completing the **introduction**.

CHORDS ORDER FOR THE VERSE AND THE BRIDGE

THE WEEKND - SAVE YOUR TEARS				
BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION		
C (x2)	C major (x4)	C/E/G		
A (x2)	A minor (x4)	E - A - C		
E (x2)	E minor (x4)	E - G - B		
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D - G - B		

To play the **first and second verses**, you will need to play this table **8 times** in a row. To play the **bridge** (after the second chorus), you will need to play this table **twice**.

CHORDS ORDER FOR THE PRE-CHORUS

THE WEEKND - SAVE YOUR TEARS			
BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION	
D (x2)	D minor (x4)	D - F - A	
A (x2)	A minor (x4)	E - A - C	
F (x2)	F major (x4)	C - F - A	
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D - G - B	

1st pre-chorus : play this table once **2nd pre-chorus :** play this table twice

CHORDS ORDER FOR THE CHORUS

THE WEEKND - SAVE YOUR TEARS			
BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION	
C (x1)	C major (x1) (4 beats)	C/E/G	
A (x1)	A minor (x1) (4 beats)	E - A - C	
E (x2)	E minor (x4)	E - G - B	
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D - G - B	

To play all **chorus**, you will need to play this table **twice**.

After the **bridge**, take this table again, this time playing all the chords the same way, and repeat this in a loop until the end of the song.
