# RIHANNA - DIAMONDS

## CHORDS

In this song, you'll find the following chords:

- G major
- B minor
- A major

CHORDS / RIHANNA - DIAMONDS		
BASS	CHORD	COMPOSITION
G	G major	D / G / B
B	B minor	D / F# / B
A	A major	C# / E / A

**ATTENTION :** The composition of those chords is interchangeable, so please feel free to adapt the compositions of the chords according to your own tastes and preferences.

For example, the G major chord can be played:

- D / G / B (see table) **(2nd inversion)**
- **But also** G / B / D **(Standard)**
- **Or** B / D / G **(1st inversion)**

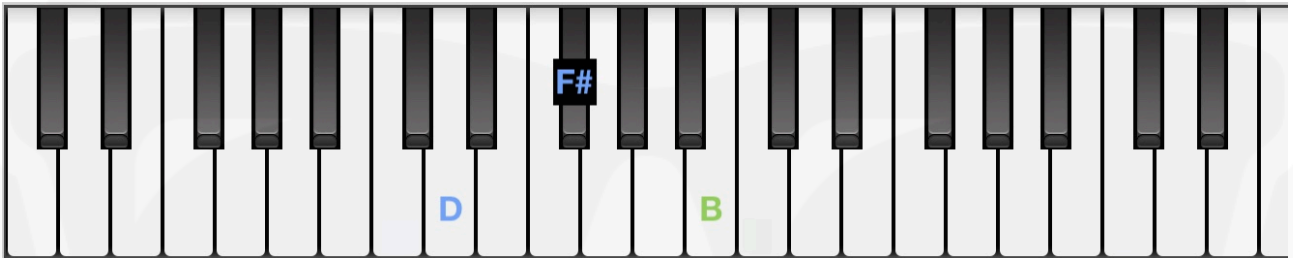

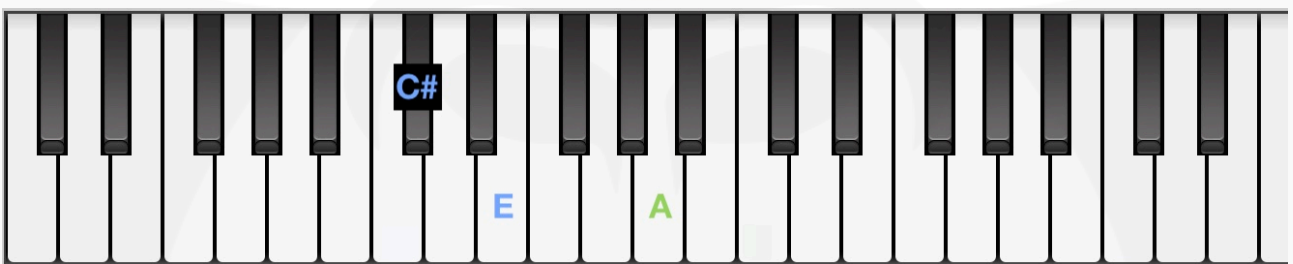
- G major

## RHYTHM

- Bass+Chord / Chords x2 / Bass+Chord

### Chords order for the ENTIRE song

CHORDS / RIHANNA - DIAMONDS		
BASSE	ACCORD	COMPOSITION
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D / G / B
B (x2)	B minor (x4)	D / F# / B
A (x3)	A major (x6)	C# / E / A
B (x1)	B minor (x2)	D / F# / B

**Introduction :** Play once with sliding chords.

**1st verse :** Play the table 4 times (*Don't play the last B minor at the 4th repetition*)

**Chorus :** Play the table 4 times

**2nd verse :** Play the table 3 times (*Don't play the last B minor at the 3rd repetition*)

**Chorus :** Play the table 4 times

**Soft part :** Play once with sliding chords.

**Chorus :** Play the table 4 times
